TITLE IX SELF-EVALUATION CLASSES

About The Class

Participants in the Title IX self-evaluation classes learn how to conduct an analysis of an intercollegiate athletics program by actually analyzing their own programs during this intensive four-day class. The class is expected to take eight hours per day and may involve some evening hours. By the end of the four days, participants will learn not only how to conduct Title IX analyses, they will have answers regarding their institution's compliance status for the 13 program components covered by Title IX. Class sizes may range from 5 to 20 participants. Participants receive a copy of our self-evaluation manual "Title IX and Intercollegiate Athletics: How It All Works – In Plain English" as part of their tuition.

Participants must bring significant program documents with them to the class (including budgets, squad lists, coaching assignments, team schedules, scholarship information, and coaches and staff questionnaires to be completed electronically). The class will have limited value without the information specified. The complete list of information is provided to those attending the class.

Application Process

The dates of the 2010 classes, the application deadlines, and tuition payment deadlines are listed below. Tuition for each class is \$1,850.00. Payment should not be sent with the application. Class sizes are limited and not all applicants may be accepted for their preferred class. Priority is based on the order in which applications are received. Applicants who are accepted for a class but fail to pay the tuition by the due date may forfeit their place in the class.

About the Hotel / Location

The Radisson Suite Hotel (www.radisson.com/ranchobernardoca) is in the community of Rancho Bernardo in the city of San Diego, approximately 25 miles north of the San Diego airport and downtown San Diego. The hotel is one-half mile from Interstate-15, the Rancho Bernardo Road exit. Participants should make their own reservations directly with the hotel, specifying that they are attending the "Title IX Class." The Radisson honors the room rates quoted for three days before and three days after the class. Floor plans are the same for all rooms: a sitting area with fold-out couch, adjoining an open area with a king or two double beds.

Hotel features include free self-parking; complimentary full American breakfast buffet; refrigerators and microwaves in each room; complimentary cocktail and half-priced appetizers at happy hour; complimentary USA Today delivered to each room; hard-wired and wireless internet access; and free shuttle service within five miles of the hotel.
